



The Maryland General Assembly has passed a bill that seeks to amend the Maryland Constitution and create a state fundamental right to "reproductive freedom". The state will ask voters to approve the amendment language on the November 2024 general election ballot. While the term "reproductive freedom" is yet undefined, there is no question that the amendment would be used to suppress pro-life speech and action in the state. It would invalidate all existing health and safety statutes and regulations regarding abortion and bar any future attempts to pass lifesaving legislation such as a partial birth abortion or dismemberment bans. Bill sponsors have stated that the amendment includes new rights that may include commercial uses of human embryos and transgender rights including the use of puberty blocking drugs and surgical mutilation of genitalia - even among children, without parental consent.
